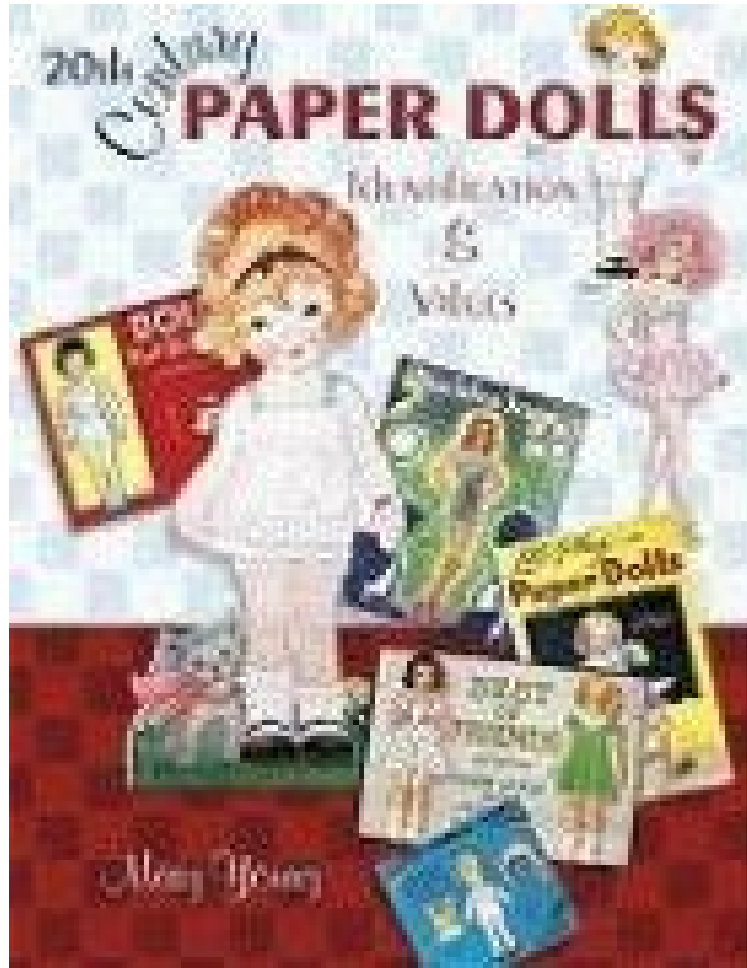

It is also enjoyable just to thumb through the book and look at the various paper dolls. Mary Young is well known for her numerous books on paper dolls that were published from the 1970s to 2000. She is back with an all-new title, 20th Century Paper Dolls, now in full color and updated with more than 1,300 photographs. Arranged alphabetically by paper doll company, the book provides brief company histories, when known, and pertinent facts for every item shown. Approximately 150 companies are featured, including Sam Gabriel, Milton Bradley, Magic Wand, McLoughlin, Dennison, Parker Brothers, Warren Paper Products, Stecher Lithographic Company, American Colortype, Burton Playthings, Transogram Toy Company, and many more. All paper dolls are identified by company and number (if they have one) and are assigned current collector values. A handy index and paper doll checklists are also provided.

Every little girl had paper dolls, so this book will be fascinating to many. I am amazed that any survived that were not cut up, but we have seen pages and books at the identification clinics I produce. You will find over 150 companies listed alphabetically with 1,300 photographs. Each photograph is accompanied by description and current retail value.
