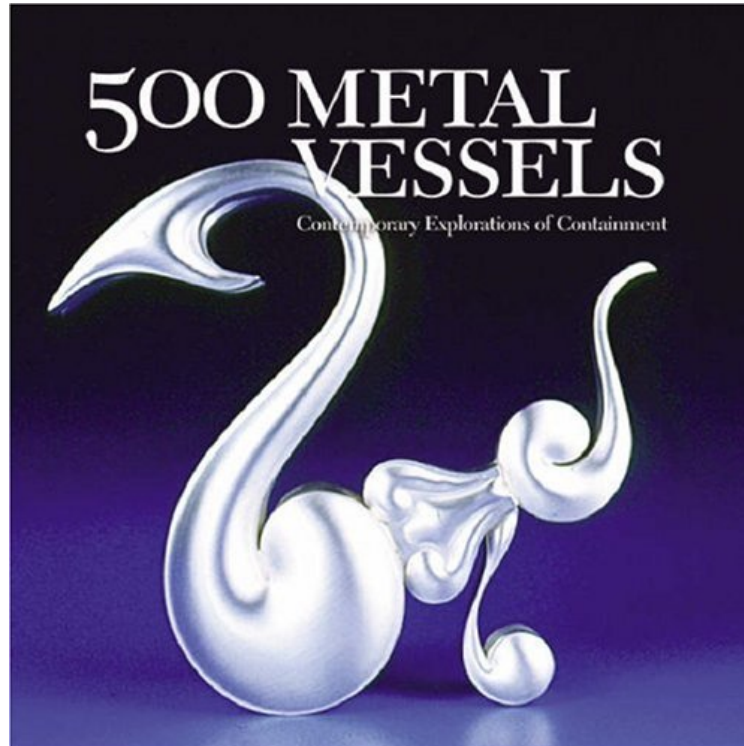


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500 Metal Vessels: Contemporary Explorations of Containment (500 Series)
