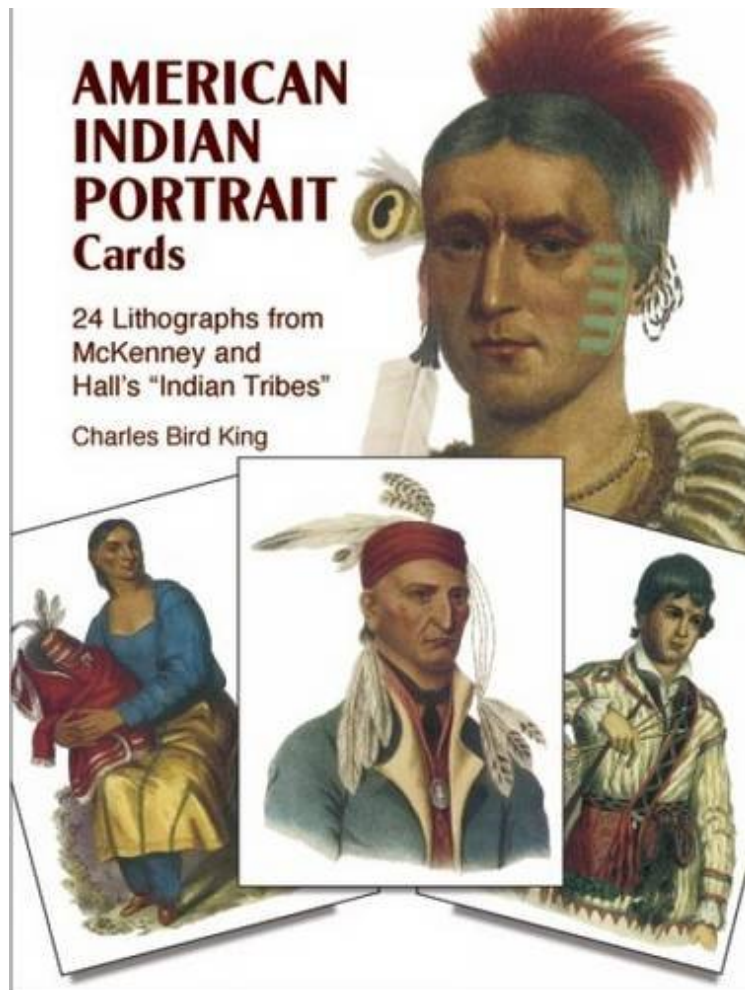

They come in a book, which I was a bit surprised about (kind of like a book of paper dolls) but which is kind of neat for ease of viewing. The cards come on a perforated sheet of 4 so when you open the book, you see a spread of 8 cards. The cards detach easily from the perforations. I found it very easy to trim off the perforated edge with a cheap paper trimmer, but I know a lot of postcard buyers don't like to do so, so please keep in mind that each card will have

TWO perforated edges. The front cover gives some historical data about the context in which the portraits were made, and the back cover provides additional information about the subjects of each card beyond the name and date, if known.
